Each province can send up to 10 entries for children below 18 years for their unique achievements, or outstanding services done by them between 1 June 2023 and 31 May 2024

Details Required

- Full name of the child
- Age of the child
- Present education status
- Description of the achievement in 150-200 words
- Good quality photograph of the child
- Copy of documents supporting the achievement

Note: Profile of child should appear in Homelink Child MISS



YaR Children's Award (Below 18 Years)

Criteria of Judgement

- Uniqueness of the service or achievement 50%
- Risk/challenge involved and/or impact 50%

YaR Alumni Award

At-risk young persons who left our institutional or non institutional care between 1 June 2008 and 31 May 2014 and have outstanding achievements

Note: Nominee should not have received YaR Alumni award in the Past

- Full name of the person
- Current age of the person with proof
- Period (start and end date) and type of service received from Don Bosco Young at Risk services
- Education and occupation status
- Description of the achievement in 150-200 words
- Good quality photograph
- Evidence in support of the achievement

Criteria of Judgement

- Uniqueness of the service or the achievement 50%
- Risk/challenge involved and/or impact 50%

YaR Innovative Programme Award

Projects/programmes distinguished for creativity and impact on the lives of the Young at Risk implemented by YaR centres/services between 1 June 2023 and 31 May 2024

- Name of the programme
- Name of the organization/individual implementing the programme
- Period of implementation of the programme
- A brief description of the programme, in 150-200 words, mentioning how it meets the criteria for the award
- Good quality photograph related to programme



YaR Innovative Programme Award

Criteria of Judgement

- Innovation newness of the idea 25%
- Replicability of the programme 25%
- Verifiable/measurable results 20%
- Target group of the programme 10%
- Relevance of the issues addressed 10%
- Reach of the programme 10%

YaR Research Award

Research by YaR Commissions/Centres/Services or Individuals on topics related to the Young at Risk and published between 1 June 2023 and 31 May 2024

- Name of the research
- Name of the person/team who has done the research
- Name of organization/centre
- Date of publication
- Synopsis in 150-200 words
- Copy of the publication





YaR Research Award

Criteria of Judgement

- Quality of the research 25%
- Research methodology and sampling 25%
- Relevance to YaR issues 20%
- Applicability/actionability 20%
- Quality of the publication 10%

Note: Submit only research-based publications

YaR Short Film Award

Documentaries, biopics, inspirational or motivational videos, of 10 to 40 minutes' duration, relevant to Young at Risk, produced by YaR Commissions/Centres/Services or Individuals between 1 June 2023 and 31 May 2024

Note: The film can be in any language. Subtitles in English are compulsory for any language other than English

- Title of the production
- Name of the producer organisation/individual
- Name of the director
- Name of the script/screenplay writer
- Date of release
- Copy of the film





YaR Short Film Award

Criteria of Judgement

- Effectiveness of the production in conveying the intended message 25%
- Originality of the theme/subject 25%
- Technical quality of the production 20%
- Relevance of the content to YaR 15%
- Aesthetic appeal of the production 15%

YaR Social Nedia

Award Impactful engagement with the public through Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, YouTube by YaR Commissions/ Centres/Services, through posts between 1 June 2023 to 31 May 2024

Note: Entries should be of Profiles opened before 31 March 2023 with not less than 10 posts

- Variety of the topics posted 20%
- Relevance/significance of the content 20%

- Engagement with the audience: likes/comments on the posts – 15%

YaR Campaign Award

Impactful engagement with the public through the initiatives/participation of children and young people of YaR Commissions/ Centres/ Services dated between 31 Aug 2023 to 30 June 2024.

Homelink Network Best Hub Coordinator Award
